House Ad Hoc Committee (Abortion) Thursday, July 7, 2022 12:00 PM – Blatt 110

- Rep. McCravy (Chair, Ad Hoc Committee)
  - Convened meeting
  - o Rep. Magnuson led the committee in prayer
  - o The committee recited the pledge of allegiance
  - o Thanked those who have come to testify
  - o Lt. Governor will appear
  - o Sen. Garrett is attending
  - o This is a public hearing on protecting the unborn
  - o Established Ground Rule
    - Hearing will be conducted in an orderly manner
    - We have one invited guest and those with special needs to allow them to testify
    - Comments will be limited to three minutes
    - Speakers should identify themselves and if they represent an organization
    - Will try to get through everyone who has signed up to speak
    - Anyone can distribute written comments
      - E-mail: <u>adhoccommittee@schouse.gov</u>
  - o Committee adopted proposed rules
- Courtney Turner Milbank (Senior Associate Attorney, Bopp Law Firm)
  - Thanked committee
  - Constitutional Lawyer
  - o Father was a long time Indiana Legislator
  - Legal landscape post Dobbs
    - Roe found a right in the US Constitution to an abortion
    - Roe setup a trimester-based system without constitutional
    - Casey set up an undue burden process
  - o Dobbs overruled Roe and Casey and established rationale basis review
  - The Roe decision was an overreach of the fourteenth amendment according to the Dobbs decision
  - Dobbs made clear that heightened scrutiny was no longer valid
  - The current standard used by the Supreme Court now includes a presumption of a state's ban
  - o Urges state to protect the right to life and provides the committee with a draft
  - o Abortions should be outlawed except to save the life of the mother
  - o Committee should outlaw of trafficking of abortion
